To serve more youth, we are relocating and combining our Boys & Girls Clubs in Beaufort into one facility for all ages (6-18). The new Club will be more accessible to the communities we serve, walkable from both the elementary and middle schools, and will double the number of youth we can serve each day – from about 65 to more than 200.

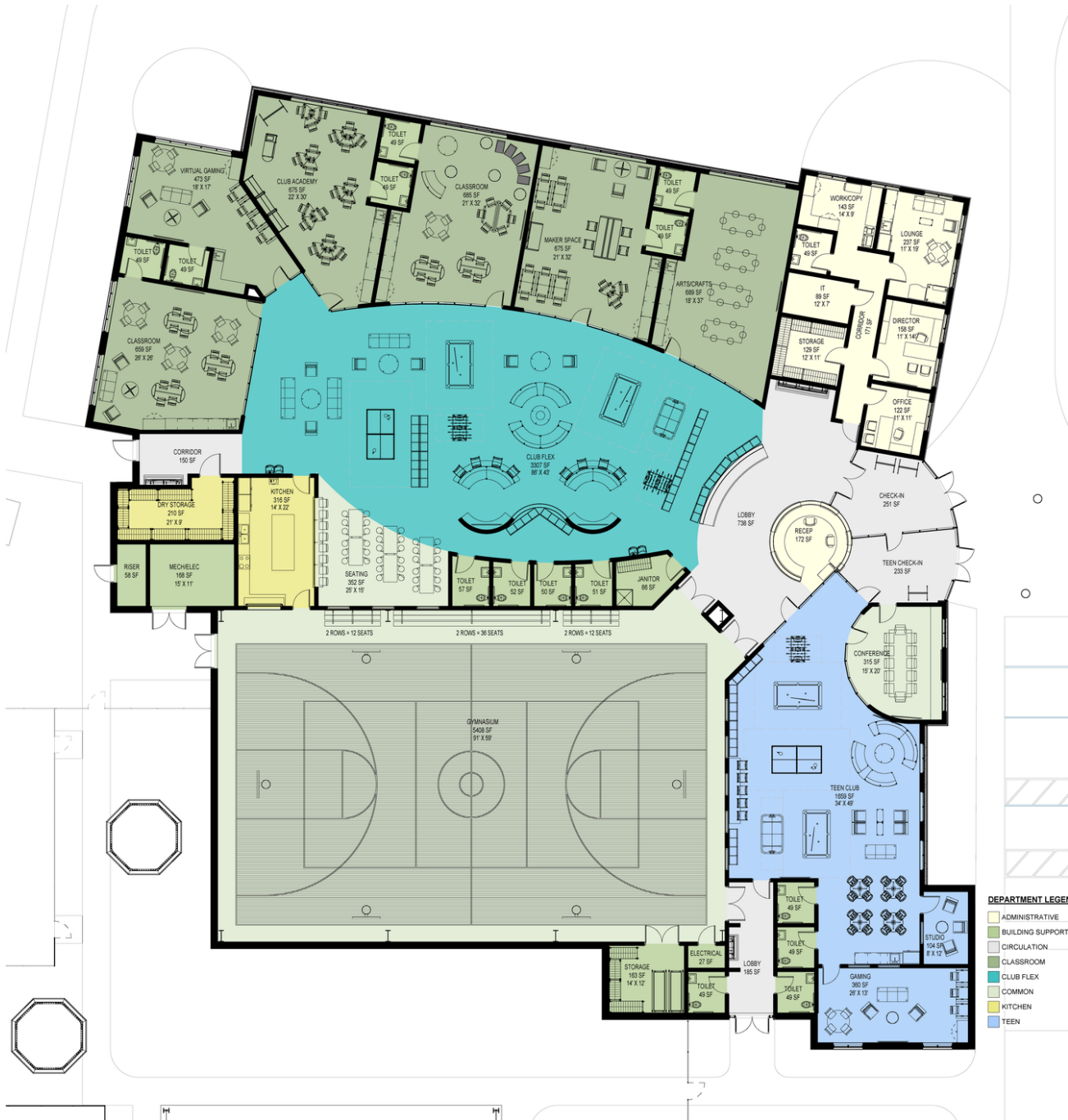


Better Futures for Beaufort

Beaufort Boys & Girls Club

Site and Construction - \$11,300,000

Our new permanent site in Beaufort is on a county-owned property that is walkable for elementary and middle school students. Dedicated spaces for programming allow us to expand age-specific programs and welcome more youth each day.

Program Improvements and Staffing - \$170,000

In Beaufort we will expand Club Academy, our successful academic tutoring program; Torch & Keystone Clubs, our leadership development programs; and our focus on social and emotional wellness.
